Lakeland Volunteer Fire Department



A critical partner for our community!

Many thanks to the hardworking men and women of the Lakeland Volunteer Fire Department serving our lake area residents! The department plays a vital role not only fighting fires, but responding to medical emergencies. As a matter of fact, of the department's 215 runs in 2022, 141 were medical related. Most of the time, they are first on the scene due to response times for EMT services around our lake area.

As a laker, one of our trustees had the opportunity to see them respond quickly to a neighbor experiencing seizures and cardiac arrest. The response time was incredible. They learned later that one of the volunteers left his family campsite in Angola to speed to the scene. This is just one example of their dedication to our community.

The department used last year's proceeds (\$14,000) from Coldwater Lake Association to purchase a cascade air compressor system to easily and quickly fill the new air packs that were purchased in 2021.

Please consider an additional donation to the department when paying your annual dues. Medical supply costs are increasing, and they are always in need of new technology and equipment.

The department, with assistance from Ovid township, is looking to purchase a very expensive LUCAS® chest compression system. This easy-to-use mechanical chest compression device gives the department needed relief when they are short staffed or there are long delays in ambulance/ EMT response.

The department continues to go through additional training. In 2022, each firefighter completed a 16-hour vehicle extraction class.

A reminder to all lakers to purchase green address signs for your mailbox for emergency vehicles to find addresses. They can be found at retailers like Home Depot and Amazon.

And don't forget to change your smoke detector batteries on a regular basis. A good reminder is to do so when the time changes. Change your clock – change your battery!

Fishing: Not just for grumpy old men!

Are you a fishing enthusiast? Many lake association members are and they are letting their voices be heard. Over the course of the past two years, Coldwater Lake Association trustees have been polling members routinely for their thoughts and feedback on a host of subjects. They have done so via digital communications and paper surveys at some of the many events hosted at the association building.

One of the more consistent messages is concerning the amount of walleye in the lake, or lack thereof. Enthusiastic anglers (and they are not all older grumpy men) within our membership seem to agree. They desire more opportunities to catch walleye while fishing in Coldwater Lake.

The Association trustees want to be responsive to all members, yet, as none of them are avid fishing persons, an education was needed. Fortunately, there are many interested parties to assist and much help was offered by member Jim Bentley.

Jim worked closely with the DNR to understand and learn about what has been done in the past, what has worked, what hasn't worked and what is the current status of fish in the lake. The DNR also provided additional assistance in understanding the positives and negatives of increasing the availability of walleye within Coldwater Lake and the best means for going about it. Thanks to Jim for his time and efforts in preparing this research and presenting to the trustees so an informed decision on how to act could be made.

Most of the fish currently dominating Coldwater Lake were originally stocked in abundance some time ago. These included bass, a variety of pan fish and northern pike. All of these species took to the habitat and established themselves in a fishery that self sustains as the environment provides the right habitat and the mix of predator fish is within control to allow for their populations to flourish. Walleye, on the other hand, have struggled to establish themselves.

Heavy stocking of walleye occurred in the past with little success. These efforts focused primarily on small spring fingerlings of 1" – 2" and were challenged in surviving against the larger predator fish already established within the lake. Hence, the current stocking effort is focused on larger fall fingerlings of 6" – 8" in size, with hopes they find more success of reaching maturity.

The Association funded and assisted in stocking 1,500 of the larger fall walleye this past October and plans are to repeat this effort over the next two years. It takes three to five years for these walleye to grow to 15 inches, the legal size for keeping them. Plans are to measure the results of these efforts after the third year with the DNR's help. The last time the DNR did a fishery assessment of Coldwater Lake was in 2014.

While it is not likely for walleye to become self-sustaining within Coldwater Lake and/or the entire chain, it is believed that an ongoing stocking program will be able to establish a balance within the fishery that will provide for all.
